Mayor Gray Leonhard called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and asked Town Clerk Yvonne Braddock to take the roll call.

Councilmember Linnie R. Richardson gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

### 4. Approval of Minutes - Mayor Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund

Mayor Gray Leonhard read the title and asked if there were any additions or deletions, if not he would entertain a motion for approval.

Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund made a motion to approve the above listed minutes as written; seconded by Council Member Linnie Richardson. All agreed, motion carries.

#### 5. NEW BUSINESS

a. Ordinance 2025-10 Annexation Torres 2<sup>nd</sup> reading

 Town Attorney Scott E. Simpson read Ordinance 2025-10 in full, Mayor Gray Leonhard asked council if they had anything to say.

Council member Linnie Richardson started off with her concerns about code violations of this property, and it looks like a dump abandoned vehicles. She believes the town would be inheriting a mess and she knows it's an annexation and revenue for town but believes it will be more of a headache for town. Mayor Gray Leonhard stated he went and looked at it and it's in bad shape and they have added more vehicles from the previous time he visited the property. Council Member Linnie Richardson would accept annexation if the property was cleaned up. Mayor Gray Leonhard has reservations about this annexation as well. Council Member Linnie Richardson brought up we have several properties on US Highway 17 that we are going to need to address. Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund stated maybe we need to notify the petitioner that we have some reservations about your property and you need to straighten it up. Lester Pulley is the same property that had mechanic shop. Denise Colflesh is the one they wanted to annex a few years back. Resident Sue Elliot, I pass it regularly and they are bringing in more junk. Vice Mayor must be notified. Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund asked if they should table it again, and Town attorney Scott Simpson advised we may have to start over. Town Planner stated we must notify County Manager. Mayor Gray Leonhard stated he would entertain a motion to table.

Council Member Linnie Richardson made a motion to deny Ordinance 2025-10, 2025-11 and 2025-12 at its 2<sup>nd</sup> reading as written; seconded by Council Member Jimmy Anderson. All agreed, roll call vote taken, motion carries.

Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund stated would it give us more jurisdiction to control the appearance of the property. Mayor Gray Leonhard stated we don't have the teeth to enforce it. Town Attorney stated yes. Town Planner Mark Karet explained the violation is for zoning. Mayor, they want to change it to heavy commercial. Council Member Linnie Richardson stated it's a junk yard. Town Attorney says we can annex but not change zoning. Vice Mayor Robert Greenlund stated why don't we table this and tell them our intentions give them an opportunity to fix it. Town Attorney ask Town Planner how to do that. Discussion ensued. Resident Denise states denying it sends a clear message that we are not playing Council member Linnie Richardson agrees. Mayor Gray Leonhard asked Town Clerk Yvonne Braddock to do a roll call vote and ask Town Planner if we need to do it separate for each ordinance and Town planner Mark Karet stated it's one motion. Roll call vote taken to deny 2025-10,2025-11 and 2025-12.

## b. Ordinance 2025-15 Public Sleeping 1<sup>st</sup> reading

Mayor Gray Leonhard asked Town Attorney Scott Simpson to read the ordinance. Mayor asks council about a discussion. Town Attorney explains the ordinance, making sure we are following state law. He added to terms and conditions to protect saddle club and states they are not prohibited. This is designed to stop homeless camps. Discussion ensued.

Town Attorney Scott Simpson stated yes, Scott Simpson stated staff were concerned about it, but he 99 doesn't think it's a big deal, it's just a standard form. Town Planner Mark Karet states we need to 100 follow this more accurately and Town Attorney Scott Simpson agrees. Deputy Ryan Smith 101 102 explained to the committee, and he didn't put resolution in packet since we weren't sure if 103 changes were needed and we stated Pierson needs generator and New Town Center upgrades. He 104 continued its just for resolution and plan for the next 5 years. Mayor Gray Leonhard stated so they just want us to agree with it and Deputy Clerk Ryan Smith said yes. 105 106 Mayor Gray Leonhard said he would entertain a motion. 107 108 Council Member Linnie Richardson made a motion to approve resolution 2025-17 as 109 written; seconded by Council Member Brandy Peterson.
